A LIST OF UNFAMILIAR WORDS & THEIR MEANINGS:-

JUSTIFICATION ~ Justification is about having right legal standing before God ie the believer cleansed by the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. The believer can stand before God "just-as-if-I'd-never-sinned"

PROPITIATION ~ The sacrifice that bears God's wrath for all time, and so changes it to His favour. Hence Jesus dying in the place of each and every one of us has changed God's wrath into favour for all who accept the Lord Jesus Christ as their Saviour.

TRANSGRESSION ~ Sin eg those actions which are against the Commandments of God ~ see Exodus chapter 20
